

SIMPLA UBIQUIT MUDGUARDS - NATIONAL PRODUCT AT WORLD LEVEL

Before I start the description of the tested mudguard I think it is worth mentioning a few words about the brand: Simpla is the only Polish factory producing plastic mudguards for bicycles. The offer of the company is over several dozen models adapted to urban and mountain riding, road trekking and children. Simpla is a brand created by passionate fans. We have specialized in the manufacture of mudguards for bicycles by injection technology for more than 20 years. In our work, we use state-of-the-art solutions and innovations. We are actively involved in product design and implementation. We are actively involved in product design and implementation. We are a well-established team of professionals and craftsmen. We work with designers, artists and local institutions as well as with the State Higher Vocational School in Nysa and Częstochowa. This year we have expanded our offer of two-component products - which allows us to introduce a wide range of colours, personalization and modification of individual components of the mudguard.



“For a no limit ride” is a signpost of our actions. That's why we do what we do i.e. riding without limits or restrictions. Against the adversity. No matter how hard you find it, if you give it all at the finish line, just like in a cycling race you will be - the best.

The first impression after opening the box is the extraordinary richness of colourful products and high quality workmanship. The manufacturer offers its mudguards in up to fifteen different colours and everyone will find something for themselves. I selected the Ubiquit SDL 46 in titan for the test, the colour of my urban bicycle meant that the mudguards perfectly matched the colour of the bicycle. Visually the product is great, absolutely nothing to reproach, all the details worked out perfectly. We are glad that we have a company in the country that can take care both of design and good quality of workmanship. If it were not for the logo of the manufacturer on the clip that masks the mudguards (which also looks great), it would be hard to imagine that these mudguards were made in our beautiful country.



The SDL is designed to protect the entire wheel and is designed for 28-inch wheels. It is made of two types of plastic with different degree of stiffness, thanks to which the mudguard is more stable. At the end of the both, the front and rear mudguards, there is something like a rubber "splatter" - a very nice treat for the eye and added several points to the appearance of Ubiquit.



Steel wires and screws with hex nuts as well as plastic elements are all frame attachments. Assembly of the entire front and rear set takes about 10 minutes, the manufacturer provides very clear assembly instructions in four languages.

It's time to ride. As for a decent test, I was able to ride my urban bicycle in the rain. I waited a long time and I was pleasantly surprised. In spite of heavy rain, I did not find any dots of mud or other asphalt surprises on my clothes, and my boots were still at decent levels. Ubiquit passes its test very well. Frankly, I see this product also as a great winter mudguard thanks a large narrow wheel that is used on the roadway (the mounting system greatly limits the quick pull and installation of these mudguards). The fully covered wheel and reflective element, red or yellow, are unmistakable on wet and long road trips in winter with poor visibility.
